CAPITAL PAYROLL AND INTEX EARNIE PAYROLL

Capital and Intex customers that are still using Windows 98 may experience certain problems when printing reports following the next scheduled upgrade. Last year the solution was to revert to Crystal 8 for such reports. Unfortunately that will not be available for the next release (Payroll EOY Processing) in early 2007.

The problem particularly affected those using Kyocera printers. It has been found that downloading the latest drivers from the Kyocera Mita website have sometimes solved the issue. The site can be accessed by clicking ([here](#)).

Additionally, it has been found that using a local printer (rather than networked) has shown benefits. However, the infallible solution is to upgrade the operating system to the latest Windows platform.

PAYROLL END-OF-YEAR PROCESSING

We are again planning to hold a seminar highlighting the changes incorporated in the payroll releases, and the processes required to complete your end of year routines, including the submission of your annual returns.

As soon as we have fuller details we will advise you through our newsletters.

Currently we involved with Pegasus in validating their Opera II payroll releases (v5.10.00 and v4.20.00) so we are privileged to know the form the above changes are likely to take.

REVISED HMRC GUIDANCE ~ OPERATION OF PAYE & CLASS 1 NIC

Further guidance has been issued by HMRC regarding the treatment of payrolls normally falling due on a non-banking day (Saturday, Sunday or Bank Holiday).
