DOING IT ON-LINE: HOW HMRC CHANGES WILL AFFECT YOU

All large and medium sized companies, and a good proportion of smaller employers now file their Employer Annual Returns (P35 and P14s) using on-line facilities. Now is the time, however, when you should start to consider sending your in-year PAYE forms on-line too.

As from a year this coming April, all medium sized employers (those with over 50 employees) must send their employee starter and leaver, and similar pension information, on-line. All employers, regardless of how many employees you have, will be required to submit this information on-line from 6 April 2011.

Each of the payroll systems supplied through Computerwise will have the necessary validation and processing to comply with the forthcoming regulations, but you do need to put these into effect, and there is no reason why this should not be put in place now.

OPERA II VERSION 5.14.00

We are pleased to advise you that the latest version of Opera II has been released, and we are commencing its distribution to all users.

This version has been tested with the Business and Ultimate editions of Windows Vista, Microsoft's latest operating system.

The software also includes the necessary changes to support the Royal Bank of Scotland and NatWest Bankline application together with a number of service updates.

Whilst it is not urgent that users convert to this release, it is important that systems containing payroll and personnel modules are upgraded from v4.20 before the commencement of the payroll upgrade season. This is because the upgrade from version 4 to 5 can be challenging and it would be prudent to complete this change before the end of year. (There will not be an equivalent V4 payroll release in 2008 as occurred in April of this year.)
